-There are approximately 376 million practitioners in the world. 3 sects of Buddhism:-Mahayana- the Great Vehicle; dominant in East Asia-China, Japan, Korea; most common.-Vajrayana- the Diamond/Thunderbolt Vehicle (also known as Tibetan Buddhism; this is the way the Dalai Lama follows); dominant in Tibet, Ladakh, and Bhutan.

Buddhism - World Religions

There are two main types, Theravada, which spread to Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Thailand, Cambodia and Laos, and Mahayana which spread to Nepal, Vietnam, China, Korea and Japan. Mahayana took on aspects of the cultures where it was practiced and became three distinct branches: Vajrayana Buddhism or Tibetan Buddhism, Pure Land Buddhism and Zen Buddhism.

To become a Buddhist a person must be committed to three central beliefs. These are known as the three jewels as they are felt to be so precious. They consist of a belief in Buddha, in his teaching (this is known as Dharma which word also covers the practice of what Buddha taught) and in the Buddhist community (called Sangha).
