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Cefr Level A1 English Language

The six levels within the CEFR are A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, and C2. These six reference levels are widely accepted as the European standard for grading an individual's proficiency in around forty different languages. Each level is divided into four kinds of competences (language skills), describing what a learner is supposed to be able to do in reading, listening, speaking and writing. The A Levels: Basic User. English test C1 (Advanced English) Can understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognise implicit meaning. Can express him/herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. Can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes.

English level A1 is the first level of English in the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), a definition of different language levels written by the Council of Europe. In everyday speech, this level would be called "beginner", and indeed, that is the official level descriptor in the CEFR, also used by EF SET.

A1 level: a newbie. A1 is at the bottom of the CEFR language levels hierarchy. At this level, you're not too occupied with grammar and stuff. You simply concentrate on exchanging the basic information, like introducing yourself, or leading effective small talk around " where are you from " and " do you have a dog ".

English test A1 (also known as A1 CEFR or ESOL Entry Level 1 or GESE Grade 2) is speaking and listening test, an interview with the examiner for around 6 minutes. Candidates need basic communication skills to crack this test. ESOL stands for 'English for Speakers of Other Languages', CEFR stands 'Common European Framework Reference for Languages' & GESE stands for 'Graded Examinations in Spoken English'.

Level A1 corresponds to basic users of the language, i.e. those able to communicate in everyday situations with commonly-used expressions and elementary vocabulary.

CEF Levels The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF or CEFR) was put together by the Council of Europe as a way of standardising the levels of language exams in different regions. It is very widely used internationally and all important exams are mapped to the CEFR. There are six levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2. These are described in the table below.

Level A2 Spouse/Partner English Test It is a requirement for the Home Office to demonstrate that you have at least an A1 level of English for those applying for a 'family of a settled person' visa. This was previously known as 'spouse or partner' visa and is measured by the common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

The CEFR organises language proficiency in six levels, A1 to C2, which can be regrouped into three broad levels: Basic User, Independent User and Proficient User, and that can be further subdivided according to the needs of the local context. The levels are defined through 'can-do' descriptors.
