### Mentoring in Schools Proposal

Youth mentoring programs need a vision and mission statement that clearly describes why the program exists and the meaningful change it hopes to produce. For programs embedded in larger agencies, your goals and objectives for mentoring relationships should align with your agency's overall mission and vision.

### Program Planning & Design: Curriculum - MENTOR

Unite for Youth will focus primarily on middle school youths. It is projected that within three years, 50% of the system's students will be in middle school. This age group is particularly problematic and a perfect time for mentoring to be effective. Unite for Youth's mentoring programs will pair a youth with mentor for 12 months.

Attend a new mentor training if possible in the summer or early fall. Structure the Mentoring Program Determine the purpose, type of youth/student needs, goals, mentoring model, and structure of the program Develop your program plan, goals, outcomes, etc. Consider utilizing or developing a theory of change. Assign/hire program coordinator.
